## ONLINE REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

### **ALL ENTRIES**

Upon registering your first animal, you will be asked to digitally enter a W-9 (stored online in a secure location). This will only be asked for one time and will need to be completed prior to continuing the registration process.

### **LARGE LIVESTOCK ONLY**

**OTHER FORM ITEMS THAT WILL NEED TO BE UPLOADED** (If you register early, you have until the registration deadline to upload these):

[ ] **2 PHOTO'S** – these must be uploaded by the registration deadline

**ALL OF THE ABOVE PHOTO'S MUST BE UPLOADED BY THE ONLINE MARKET REGISTRATION DEADLINE TO COMPLETE YOUR REGISTRATION FOR THE NORTHERN ARIZONA JUNIOR LIVESTOCK AUCTION.** All entries must be complete, and photos approved to be eligible. We strongly recommend you submit your paperwork early in case any corrections need to be made.

Immediate family members may register the same Back-Up animal; not to exceed 2 registered animals per exhibitor.

**BACKUP ANIMALS WILL NEED TO HAVE A SEPARATE PHOTO ENTRY FOR EACH  
BACKUP ANIMAL YOU ARE ENTERING**

**Picture Instructions:** Pictures need to easily identify animal and exhibitor

**PHOTOGRAPH #1** – Picture must clearly show side profile of animal, NAJLA tag, and face of exhibitor.

**PHOTOGRAPH #2** – Picture must clearly show the head of the animal with NAJLA tag in ear.

**Photo Technique suggestions:**

- **Do not take the quality of your photo lightly.** If your photo does not identify both the exhibitor and the animal, it may result in disqualification of your entry. Your picture must be a clear image of both the animal and the exhibitor, not too dark or light. **The exhibitor and the animal need to be seen in detail.**
- It helps to take a picture during feeding.
